

T. H. ROBSJOHN-GIBBINGS (1905-1976)

A pair of rare and important side tables in carved fruitwood. Each table raised on three hand-carved legs in the form of animal haunches. These tables are from one of the earliest collections of furniture designed by Robsjohn-Gibbings based on forms used in ancient Greece.
